- When it's not getting better.

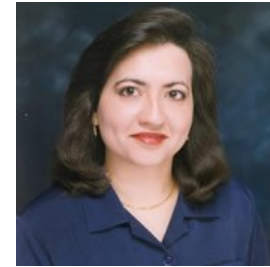
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***Talking with a psychologist experienced in working with infertility issues can help you...***
